#### **Parking**

Free parking is available in the <u>Guided bus carpark</u>, a short walk from the Library. The nearest <u>long stay</u> car park is 'The Cattle Market' Car Park which is adjacent to the venue. The entrance to the car park is from Meadow Lane which is situated between <u>Harrison Way and Cromwell Place</u>. Once in the car park turn left into the Long stay car park. On foot head towards <u>Waitrose</u>. The Library is situated just before it.

Blue badge parking bays are situated nearby in <u>Station Road</u> and in front of Library in the '<u>Cattle Market (Waitrose)</u>' <u>carpark</u>. This car park is situated just beyond the long stay car park on your left and is signposted.

# By Bus

St Ives is situated on the Guided Bus Route with Routes A, B and C stopping in the town centre near the junction of Market Street and Station Road or the bus station. The venue is a 3 minute walk.
