Tackling the funding crisis in Cambridgeshire and Peterborough

- 5. The decision to maintain the suspension of NHS-funded IVF treatment until the CCG's financial stability returns falls hardest on those who are affected by infertility. Other non-specialist fertility treatments are still available to local people struggling to start a family. Read more on our website:

- 6. As reported last time the CCG is needing to save £33million. So far, the decisions made are relatively limited (we are told 15 % cuts approved to 1% of the budget) focussing on efficiencies and duplications in community services (out of hospital care). We heard assurances the safety of patients is not threatened. To close the whole system £192 million gap, NHS Trusts are also making annual cost improvements. Healthwatch will seek to understand the effects of all these changes to the public and current service users as they take place and support conversations with the public. Healthwatch have written and circulated updates on the position¹. The CCG describe their latest actions in the Governing Body minutes from their meeting on 16th July².

Inspection of Special educational needs and disabilities in Peterborough

- 7. The Care Quality Commission and Ofsted have written a statement of action following a visit to services for children with special educational needs and disabilities (SEND) in Peterborough.
- 8. The SEND report says that there are significant areas of weakness in the local area's practice which includes implementing reforms. Since 2016 there has been momentum but there is still more to be done. One of the strengths of the local service is in how it involves children, young people, parents and carers in developing and improving services. Read our update:
