East of England Ambulance Service

Purpose

1. This report introduces Paul Marshall, Cambridgeshire Sector Lead for the East of England Ambulance Service NHS Trust (EEAST).

Key issues

- 2. The Ambulance Service is a key service providing both emergency and nonemergency transport in the East of England. Providing this service consistently across a diverse and rural area such as Cambridgeshire and Peterborough can be challenging. EEAST have recently introduced a new Ambulance Response Programme to meet some of these challenges.
- 3. There is intense regulator, commissioner and media focus on urgent care services in Cambridgeshire and Peterborough who are experiencing significant winter pressures which impact upon patient experience.
- 4. The local Sustainability and Transformation Partnership are developing new approaches, such as the Extended Joint Emergency Team, to relieve some of these pressures.
- 5. Healthwatch is involved in a number of STP workstreams and collects feedback regarding urgent care services

Action required by the Board

 - Note the report and presentation, and discuss opportunities to support the development of new urgent care services.
