<p>Who we are and why we need you</p>	<p>Healthwatch Cambridgeshire and Peterborough runs the two statutory local Healthwatch services in Cambridgeshire and Peterborough.</p> <p>Our Healthwatch is your local health and social care champion. We are independent and have the power to make sure NHS leaders and other decision makers listen to local feedback and improve standards of care. We can also help you to find reliable and trustworthy information and advice.</p> <p>We are looking for friendly, compassionate volunteers to help us gather feedback from people who've used our Information and Signposting service.</p> <p>This service helps local people find the support they need with health, care, and wellbeing. Your role will help us understand what works well and what we could do better.</p> <p>Most of our volunteering roles are flexible and can fit around your schedule. <p>What we need you to do</p>	<p>We need you to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Contact people who have used our Information and Signposting service to ask about their experience. • Record their feedback accurately and securely using our digital systems. • Flag any urgent concerns or safeguarding issues to the Lead Officer promptly. • Attend regular check-ins and training sessions (virtually). • Maintain confidentiality and follow Healthwatch's data protection and safeguarding procedures
